

# TV star's dad not in new show army of fans!

ACTRESS Natalie Casey's new comedy series is lacking enthusiasm from her father ... he prefers Dad's Army.

The 21-year-old Rawtenstall actress stars in *Two Pints of Lager* and a *Packet of Crisps*, which started on Monday night on BBC2.

The comedy centres on young and gifted characters struggling to make a living in Runcorn, and also stars Ralf Little from *The Royle Family*, former *Hollyoaks* actor Will Mellor, and Beverley Callard, best known as Liz McDonald from *Coronation Street*.

This is Natalie's first major television acting appearance since she left Channel 4 soap *Hollyoaks*, but television critics slammed the comedy.
